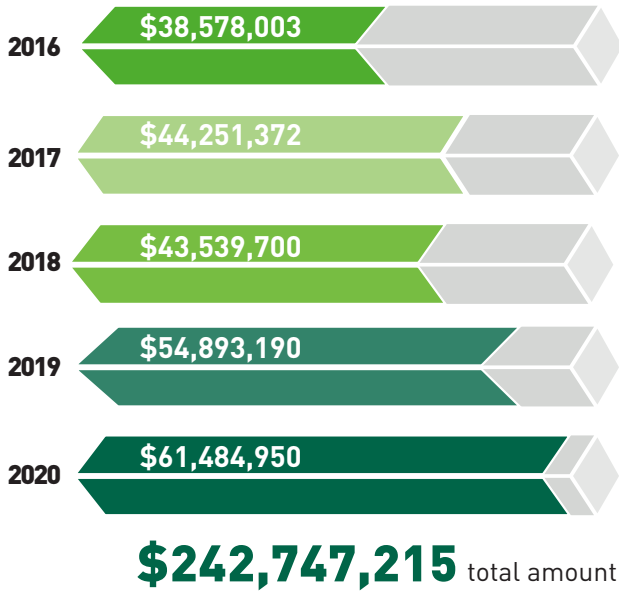

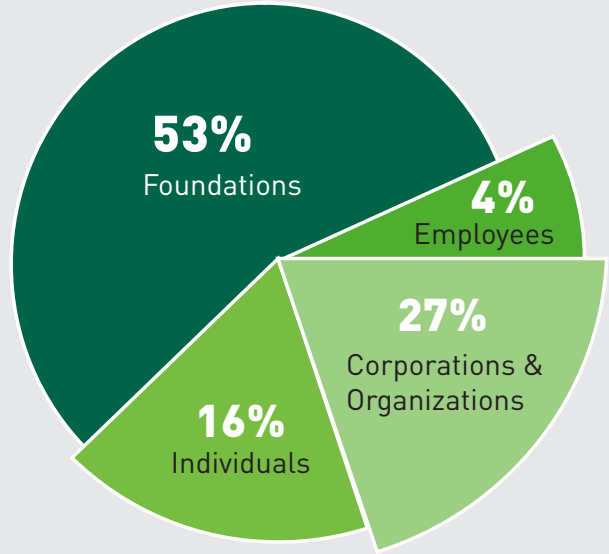

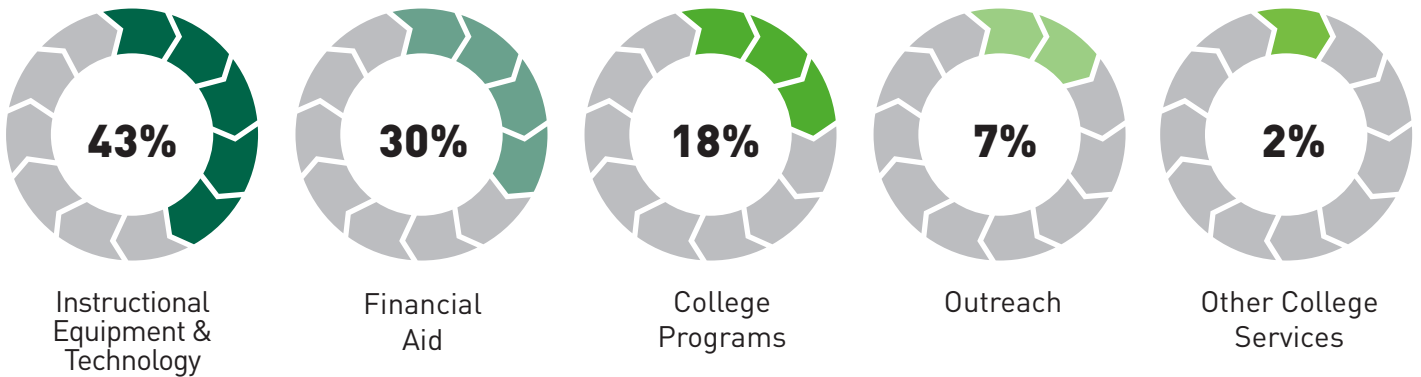
### CONTRIBUTION HISTORY



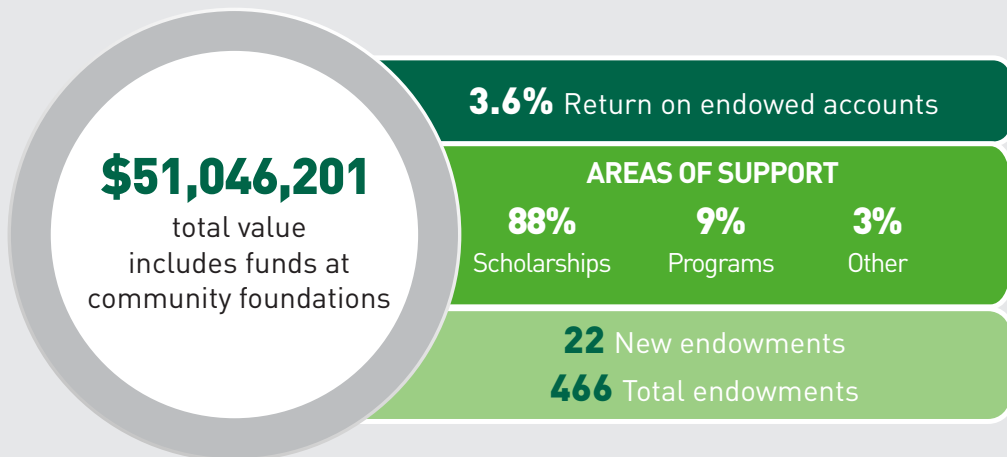
