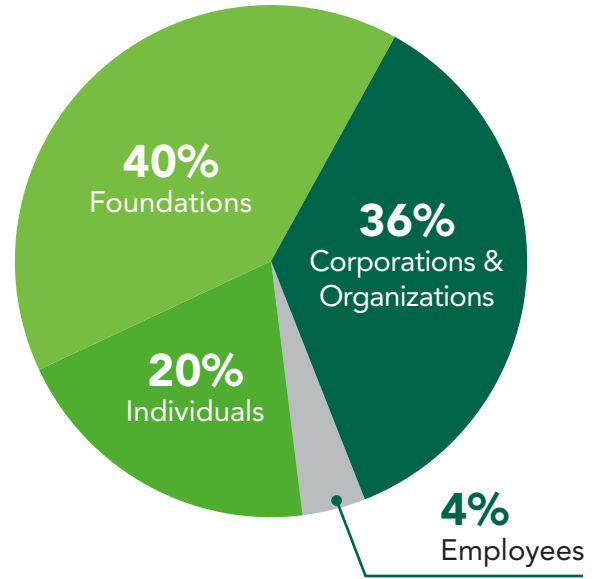

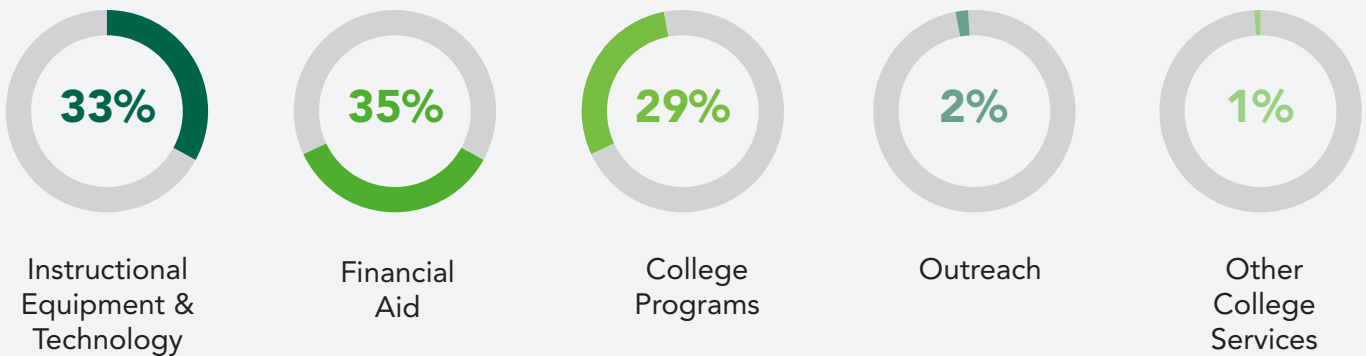

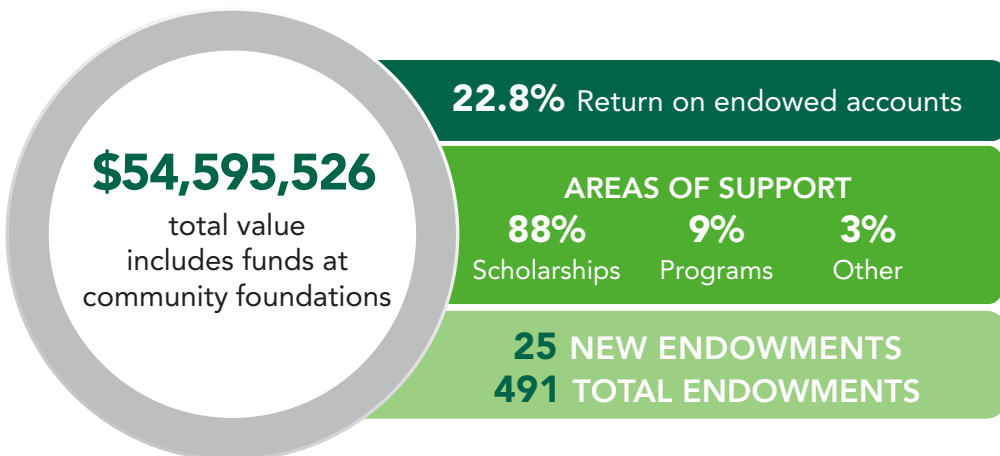
CONTRIBUTION SOURCES

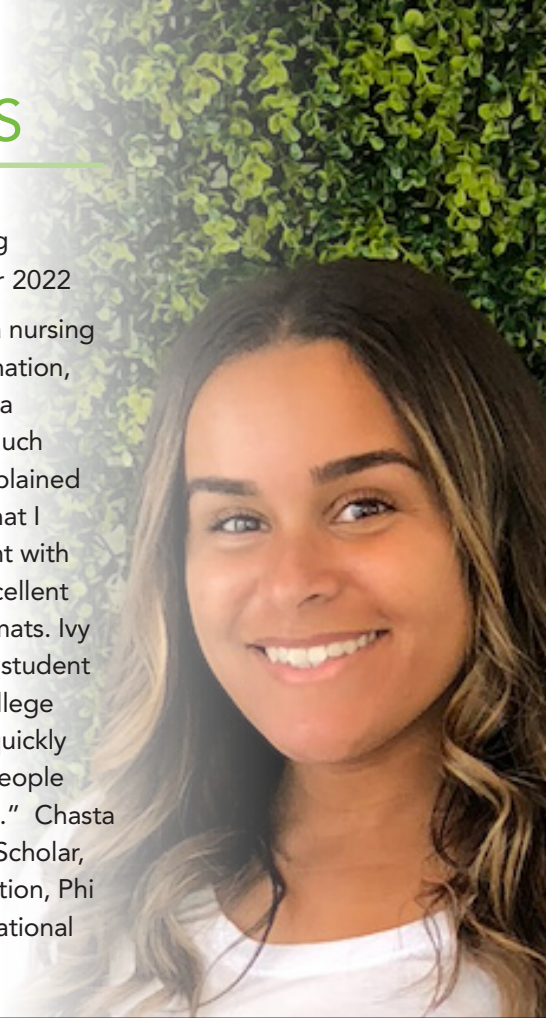
